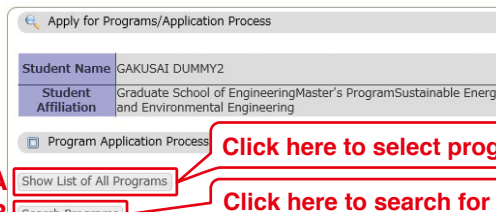
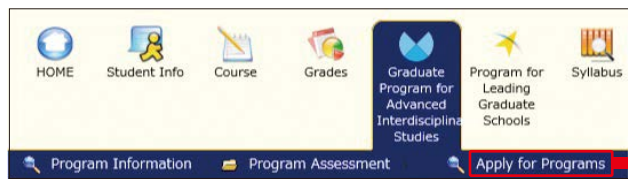
1. <Login>
